Lot 1 John Lensen GB24X06501 Chequer Hen.

John has always been a keen competitor in the Peterborough & District Federation, winning many top honors. This year in 2025 he won the most coveted prize in pigeon racing the King George V Trophy with his pigeon 'Archie' and in the Thurso race three weeks earlier he was 1st Section C, 2nd Open on a decimal from Thurso with his pigeon 'Harles' John's Soonjten Van Loon based family have proved nothing short of brilliant!

Sire is 'The 57' who is the sire of Archie 1st Open Lerwick who is the full brother to the sire of Harles 2nd Open NRCC Thurso This is a super line of top, top winning pigeons.

The Dam of '6501' is NEHO18HAR847 a super breeding Van Loon Hen that was on loan from friend Dave and Ian Maddison of Hartlepool.

Lot 2 Ross Lark Great Yarmouth A 2026 young bird from the 2024 NRCC King Cup Lerwick winner. Turning North in 2022 Ross joined the NRCC to enjoy some long distance racing. In 2024 Ross entered six birds for Lerwick and two home on the day!

Ross is only a small team fancier, his race team is just twenty strong, ten cocks and ten hens so whatever Ross produces has to be of the highest quality as there is no room at this inn for free loaders. A quality lot is offered from this small high performance loft.

Lot 3 Mr & Mrs Skinner GB25X09776 Blue Chequer cock A direct son of Tuska the 2023 NRCC Kings Cup winner for Russ and Denise Skinner. Sire is the chequer cock 'Brosca' GB18Z23499 from the late Frank Bristow 'double Kings Cup Winner' His sire is Oscar 1st Open Lerwick 503 miles winning the Kings Cup. Dam of Brosca is none other than Bridget Bordeaux winner of 1st Open Midlands National Bordeaux flying 553 miles as a yearling, she herself is a daughter of Oscar.

Dam of 776 is Russ and Denise Skinner's own Kings Cup winner Tuska, 1st Open Lerwick, 12th Open NRCC Fraserburgh, 16th Open BICC Thurso, 21st Open BICC Lerwick and a whole host of other top prizes. Tuska is from the Euro Diamond bloodline and Reveel winner of 1st Open NRCC Thurso.

You can not go wrong with these pigeons Russ and Denise are never far away from the podium in these classic races.

Lot 4 Hardy & Wilson Peterborough A 2026 Young Bird Another Kings Cup winning loft the origin of Arthur and Nathans birds are from the National and international winning lofts of Geoff and Catherine Cooper and more recently the birds of Jele Jellama, It is from these bloodlines that won the partnership the Kings Cup in 2023 from one of the most arduous race that we have experienced from Lerwick in recent years.

Lot 5 A 2026 Young Bird David Brackenbury Boston. Dave won the 2021 Kings Cup race from Lerwick. Of course that isn't Dave's only success with the NRCC in the previous years he has been twice second open from the very same race, first open Young Bird Bewick and first open from Fraserburgh 5,331 birds from 331 miles, but as Dave will openly admit there is nothing like getting your name on the Kings Cup from Lerwick.

Dave's family of pigeons are built around long distance performance birds that have been tried and tested on the North & the South road classic races.

Lot 6 Steff Dangerfield St. Normanton A 2026 young bird from Steff's 2025 NRCC Thurso winner.

Steff has only been with the club for three years and more than making his mark. This year Steff was 1st Open from Thurso racing into Derbyshire. Steff sent 10 birds to Thurso and clocked all 10 finishing 1st, 2nd, 9th, 13th, 17th, 30th, 38th, 69th, 159th & 181st from 1,071 birds, a super result and three weeks later he finished 10th Open at Lerwick clocking at 21.30rs after his pigeon had put in a fifteen and half hour fly.

Lot 7 Andrew Pinner GB25X08104 Blue Hen. A summer bred full sister to the NRCC Dunbar winner also full sister to 1st federation Whitby and 2nd east section breeder buyer this year winning £1000

Andy Pinner is known by many who visited Frank Taskers stand at any of the trade shows over the years as Andy worked along side Frank for many years.

Recently Andy won 1st Open NRCC Thurso and this year won the clubs opening race from Dunbar. He has won the federation averages the NRCC Old Bird Averages

Andy's loft is based on the F & A tasker pigeons and more recently Bob Boltons many NRCC champions were passed to Andy where they have played a great part in Andy's recent successes in the Petebrough & District Federation

Lot 8 Steve Kaschner Norfolk GB24X03864 Blue Cheq Cock

A Van den Bulck combined with the super Coreman bloodlines from pigeons from Steve's friend Bob Fenech, he is direct from Steve's 1st BICC Section winner, his full sister the Ace pigeon in the Diss club in 2025 - Steve and his partner Bridget's pigeons have been threatening this win for a while now and actually finished 1st & 2nd Open Perth.

Their family of pigeons are based on birds from Fenech Bros, Nick Barran and Tom Burkill and are fierce competitors always aiming for the top.

Lot 9 Scott Walker GB24V68526 (Old Ring Late bred for this sale bred 2025) Grizzle

This stunning young pigeon is the same way as the 2025 NRCC 1st Open Fraserburgh winner. The sire is of Leo Hermans origin wife is dam is Hermans and van den Bulck origin via Nick Barran. Scott Walker the young guy who is certainly making his mark in the NRCC. Last year Scott won the Fergus Wilson Trophy for the Best Average Velocity from Perth & Only a small team of pigeons are flown from this loft and when the pigeons are asked a question, well answer they do. 1st Open NRCC Fraserburgh for this small but very competitive loft.

Lot 10 GB25V26094 Cheq W/F. Matt Mason Conningsby In his first season with the NRCC Matt won 1st Open NRCC Young Birds with 'Billy Mason' who won 17 prizes and the East Midland Region award.

Each season even though having to put a team of pigeons together he has most certainly made his presence felt with his top drawer results.

In the tough Thurso race Matt clocked 14 of his 20 birds on the day before 20:30hrs finishing, 14th Open with a whole string of other birds dotted through the result.

At Lerwick he was 5th Open Lerwick with 4 birds very early the next morning.

'094, is from WD779 and exceptional racer for Matt winner of many prizes and bred by Wade Bros of County Durham from their top racing cock 19x23536 a winner of Open races and many many prizes were paired to a sister of Auckland Joe 1st West Durham Amal Arras 2,000b and any other prizes.

Dam of '094, is from Jimmy Dutton's Alex Docx pigeons being from Steve Mayletts North West Grand National winner when coupled to a federation winning hen. The bird is full to the brim of modern day winning bloodlines.

Lot 11 Mr Mrs Evans GB25X11264 Blue Pied Cock.

This is one super pigeon bred in the purple soaked in NRCC Open winning blood.

Sire was 1st Open Thurso 2025 and 2 x winner of 1st open federation. **Dam** was 5th Open Thurso in the same race and is also winner of 1st federation

These are down from Daves friend Guy Everate and also contain the lines of Dave and Pats previous 1st Open NRCC Thurso winner.

What can we say about Pat & Dave Evans, 13 NRCC victories, countless club and federation wins to modest back garden loft that wins out of turn. Their family of pigeons are based on those of F & A Tasker and from their Belgian friend Guy Everate with a few choice introductions based on performance.

Registration
